
## **UB-Study Circle (33rd Session)**

The 33rd study circle of universal briefing took place on 31st August at 7.30 pm. The speaker for the session was Dr. Nikita Lama, Assistant Professor, Department of Library & Information Science, University of Calcutta and the President of the session was Dr. Tapan Barui, Assistant Professor, Department of Library and Information Science, University of North Bengal, Darjeeling, West Bengal. The topic of the study circle was "Mapping the Emerging Literatures Covered in Dewey Decimal Classification: a study".

The speaker gave an amazing speech on the topic comprising the literatures which have been covered in DDC rather than in the field of literature. Development of Literature's sub division in DDC from 23rd edition to 1st edition of DDC was shown. Her areas of interest were literature by, which are not known generally by western countries or the literature from developing nations. She also pointed out a fallacy in the periods of different literatures under this section as the time of origin & development of the languages are different. Dr. Lama outlined Table 3 of DDC with its divisions and explained Modern Indic literature especially Nepali Literature. She also spoke about the problems of occurring class number of Nepali literature in different editions of DDC. Besides, she gave examples of other language's literatures too. Through the study, the speaker highlighted the lack of uniformity in the emerging literatures in DDC.








## **UB - Latest Publication**







# LETTEN Special Report under GLAM

The National Archives of India serves as the guardian of the Government of India's records of enduring value. Founded on March 11, 1891, in Calcutta (now Kolkata) as the Imperial Records Department, it has grown to become the largest archival repository in South Asia. The Archives holds an extensive collection, including public records, private papers, oriental manuscripts, cartographic records, and microfilms. These resources are invaluable for scholars, administrators, and other users seeking detailed historical information.


The Director General of Archives oversees the Department, which is responsible for implementing the Public Records Act, 1993, and its associated Public Records Rules, 1997. This mandate involves the management, administration, and preservation of public records across various Central Government Ministries, Departments, and Public Sector Undertakings.

Located in the heart of New Delhi, the National Archives functions as an Attached Office of the Ministry of Culture. It operates a Regional Office in Bhopal and Records Centres in Bhubaneswar, Jaipur, and Puducherry. The Department celebrated its 125th anniversary during 2015-16, marking a significant milestone in its long history of preserving and managing India's archival heritage.

Key facts: The Imperial Record Department was established in Calcutta on 11 March 1891, with Prof. G.W. Forrest appointed as the Officer in charge. The building plan for the department in Delhi was sanctioned on 12 October 1912, and the first session of the Indian Historical Records Commission (IHRC), a consultative body of the department, was held in Shimla on 19-20 June 1919. In the same year, Sir Rai Bahadur Jamini Mitra became the first Indian head of the department.







The office in its current building in New Delhi opened on 1 November 1926, and by March 1937, the transfer of records from Calcutta to New Delhi was completed. Scholars were permitted to consult pre-1859 records from 1939, followed by the establishment of the Conservation Research Laboratory (CRL) in 1940. In 1942, the department began its publication program and initiated a systematic survey of private archives at the behest of the IHRC. A formal course in archival training was launched in 1943, and the department's journal, The Indian Archives, was first published in 1947. The department's name was officially changed from the Imperial Record Department to the National Archives of India on 30 August 1947. In 1948, the department began a project to obtain microfilm copies of documents of Indian interest from global repositories. By 1951,

the hand lamination technique for repairing fragile documents was developed, and in 1952, personal files of the renowned mathematician S. Ramanujan were received. The National Committee of Archivists was established in 1953, and a regional office in Bhopal was set up in 1956. The Historical Document Purchase Committee was constituted in 1957, followed by the Archival Legislation Committee in 1959. The department launched a pilot project for records management in 1962 to assist various government agencies. In 1970, historical research rules for accessing records were notified, and the Archival Policy Resolution was adopted in December 1972. During the Silver Jubilee of India's independence, the "March Toward Freedom" exhibition was organized in February 1973. The South West Asia Regional Branch of the International Council on Archives (SWARBICA) was established in 1976, and the Records Management Committee submitted its report on 1 June 1976. In December 1976, the Institute of Archives Training was established in separate premises, and the Records Centre in Jaipur was inaugurated in 1977. The first Archives Week was celebrated from 7-13 August 1978, and the Reco<mark>r</mark>ds Ce<mark>nt</mark>re in Pondicherry was established in 1979. By 1982, any adult Indian was allowed access to non-current records. In June 1990, the Director of Archives was redesignated as the Director General of Archives. The department celebrated its centenary on 11 March 1991, and the Public Records Act was passed in 1993. The Records Centre in Bhubaneswar was inaugurated on 1 March 1996, followed by the notification of the Public Records Rules in 1997. An Archives Museum was inaugurated by then-President K.R. Narayanan on 6 July 1998, and digitization work began in the department the same year. The curtain-raiser for the department's 125th foundation year celebration was launched on 11 March 2015, with the release of a commemorative logo. On 23 January 2016, 100 declassified files related to Netaji were released by the Hon'ble Prime Minister, along with the launch of the web portal netajipapers.gov.in. The grand finale of the year-long celebration of the 125th foundation year took place from 7-11 March 2016. On 28 October 2016, a total of 303 declassified files related to Netaji were made available in the Delhi domain. The exhibition "Swachhagraha: Bapu ko Karyanjali," commemorating 100 years of Champaran Satyagraha, was inaugurated by Prime Minister Narendra Modi on 10 April 2017, followed by another exhibition, "Sabarmati Shalabdi: Ek Karyanjali," on 29 May 2017 in collaboration with the Sabarmati Ashram, marking the 100-year completion of the Ashram.
