#### **UB-Study Circle (34th Session)**

The 34th study circle of universal briefing took place on 28th September at 7.30 pm. The speaker for the session was Avijit Naskar, Librarian, PM Shri Kendriya Vidyalaya Bagafa (BSF), Tripura and the President of the session was Dr. Swapan Khan, Librarian, Narasinha Dutt College, Howrah, West Bengal. The topic of the study circle was "Stylometric Study: a practical approach".

The speaker gave an interesting speech on stylometric study. He delved into the fascinating world of stylometric analysis, a tool that analyses the linguistic style of writing. He explained how stylometry uses statistical methods to analyse the stylistic features of written text and how it can be utilised for analysing the pattern as well as the similarity or difference between the writings of authors. The speaker also illustrated some analysis of a corpus developed by him, using the R software. His case studies showed how stylometry can help us understand collaborative writing and identify impositions. In a nutshell, the study highlighted that as stylometric studies comprise examining patterns in word choice, sentence structure, and punctuation, it can not only provide insights about the content, but it can also be a guiding tool for plagiarism detection.




Any kind of scholarly work provides a serendipity of reading so many novel academic contents

#### **Trends on Tech**

#### **ELICIT:**

"Elicit is a research assistant using language models like GPT-3 to automate parts of researchers' workflows. Currently, the main workflow in Elicit is the Literature Review. If anyone ask a question, Elicit will show relevant papers and summaries of key information about those papers in an easy-to-use table." Elicit is dynamic. A summary of the top papers is presented along the left-hand navigation and is updated continuously as users remove irrelevant papers from the list. References may be starred and stored on a separate page for easy consultation later.

#### Strength:

Elicit uses a process-based ML system and, when compared to other systems such as outcome-based systems, process-based ML systems provide "better differential capabilities", whereby the system may perform tasks even though the outcomes are not accessible. It is a tool that streamlines the literature review process by retrieving eight papers most likely to answer the question, extracting, and summarizing important elements or variables based on user preference. References may be starred for easy retrieval later. Since this is still a relatively new product, elicit developers are regularly publishing enhancements and new features. They are receptive to feedback from end users.

#### Weakness:

Elicit is limited to publications in Semantic Scholar so there is a gap in the literature on what is being retrieved. For example, Semantic Scholar does not search licensed journals or behind paywalls and a recent study in 2018 found that Google Scholar contained 389 million records while Semantic Scholar had 40 million records. It does not have a search interface in the traditional sense; it is not designed to be searched by using keywords with search syntax (e.g., truncation) or controlled vocabulary. The machine encourages users to enter full research questions such as "How does iron supplementation affect anemia?" This could be a limitation since researchers need to ask the right questions for the right papers to be returned.

Users are unable to un-star items once they have been selected and there is no functionality to organize the starred items or to remove duplicates if the same reference has been starred from different search requests. After deleting papers from the results list, users are unable to retrieve them if they accidentally deleted relevant items. Some features on the website are not intuitive. For example, certain areas are clickable but users would not necessarily know unless they clicked around the page. If a user clicked on the title under the "Starred items," they will be redirected to the Semantic Scholar page for the article, which is a useful feature that is not obvious. #### 151 years Tram Service is going to be discontinued



Kolkata's beloved Tram embodies the rich cultural heritage of the City of Joy. For 150 years, the Tram service has been an integral part of Kolkata's history, etching its presence into the city's landscape since 1873. Regrettably, the West Bengal government has made the decision to discontinue the Tram service due to challenges posed by the city's traffic, with only one route slated to remain operational.

Kolkata, India's last city with a working Tram system, will currently only operate the route between Esplanade and Maidan. This route is designed to be nostalgic, providing a picturesque joyride past sights like as the Victoria

Memorial, with the Maidan's greenery and children playing cricket and football adding to the charm.

Since its introduction in 1873, Kolkata's trams have served as a symbol of the city's identity. Kolkata's landmarks include the Howrah Bridge, Trams, and Yellow Taxis. However, the government's stance is unsurprising. The ding-ding of Kolkata's trams, now in their 151st year, has been fading for a while.

If we look back to the history of Trams, then we can see, in the beginning, the condition of the Tram was not the same as it is now. The first Trams of Kolkata were horse-driven. These were operated from Sealdah to Armenian Ghat Street. It was the time period of British India, in about 1873. This operation was discontinued in a year due to economic crisis.

The revival of Trams in Kolkata was done in the time period of Lord Rippon in 1880. Instead of horses, steam locomotive engines were started to use. As a result, it reduced the cost and time consumption became less than prior. But due to the pollution of using it, other states of India had never used this formation of Trams. Kolkata upgraded its Trams into electric-power operated in the year 1902. The first routes were Esplanade to Kidderpore and Esplanade to Kalighat.



Slowly after that all the cities of India started discontinue their Tram services due to low ridership, costing for maintaining, availability of alternate vehicles. In 1903 Patna, in 1933 Nashik & Kanpur, in 1953 Madras (Chennai), in 1963 Delhi and in 1964 Bombay (Mumbai) discontinued their Tram services. Kolkata was the only city where this service was still going on. Now, it has also come to an end.

Legally, the Tram's future is currently in the hands of the Calcutta High Court, which established an advisory group in June 2023 to provide a report on how services could be restored, maintained, and safeguarded.
