The 26th study circle of universal briefing took place on 27th January. The speaker for the session was Rupali Rupasmita Pradhan, Research Scholar, Department of Library and Information Science, Jadavpur University, and the President of the session was Dr. Soumen Mandal, Librarian, Prasanta Chandra Mahalanobis Mahavidyalaya, Kolkata. The topic of the study circle was "Beyond the Convention: Developing Green Libraries in India for Sustainable Development".

The speaker provided an overview of the green libraries. She discussed in detail the concept of green and beginning of the green movement in library. 

Obituary



It is with deep sorrow that we convey the unfortunate news of the demise of Prof. Manorama Srinath, the Former Professor and Head of the Department of Library and Information Science at the University of Madras. She passed away on January 18, 2024, succumbing to a cardiac arrest.

Prof. Manorama Srinath began her career as Technical Assistant in Library of Madras University in 1970. In 1978, she became Assistant Librarian at University of Madras. Following this, she transitioned to the role of Lecturer in the Department of Library and Information Science (DLIS) at Madras University, serving from 1982 to 1990. Progressing in her academic journey, she became a Reader in DLIS and later attained the position of Professor, holding the esteemed role from 1996 to 2007.

Throughout her career, Prof. Srinath made significant contributions to the academic community, authoring over 100 research papers published at national and international platforms. Her commitment extended beyond publications, as she diligently prepared various course materials.

In recognition of her outstanding contributions, Prof. Srinath was honored with the IATLIS Smt. N. Ratnalaxaman Rao Best Women Teacher Award in 2001. Her involvement in professional associations was extensive, as she held life memberships in organizations such as the Madras Library Association, ILA, IATLIS, IASLIC, SIS, and several others. Prof. Manorama Srinath's dedication to the field of library and information science left a lasting impact on both her colleagues and the broader academic community. We express profound sorrow and heartfelt condolences for the passing of Prof. Manorama Srinath.





Obituary



We express our condolences on the recent passing of Dr. E Rama Reddy, the former Librarian of the University of Hyderabad, on January 30, 2024. He dedicated his service to UOH from 1978 to 2005 and later served as an Advisor to the library at Satavahana University in Karimnagar from 2015.

Before joining the University of Hyderabad, Dr. Reddy contributed to the Osmania Medical College Library from October 1966 to January 1970 and subsequently served at the Osmania University Library from January 1970 to 1978.

Dr. Rama Reddy was honored with several awards for his outstanding contributions. Notably, he received the ILA-Kaula "Best Librarian Award 2003" at the 50th All India Library Conference in Baroda on December 1, 2004. Additionally, he was conferred with the "Prof. Gangadhar Rao Memorial Award, 2004" by P.S. Telugu University, Hyderabad, on December 28, 2004, and the "National Librarian 2004" award by SATKAL Trust, Chandigarh, on January 15, 2005. He also received the National Award from Chandigarh University for his role as the Best Library Administrator.

Dr. Rama Reddy played a pivotal role in initiating the DLAN (formerly PGDLAN) course at the University of Hyderabad. His significant contributions have left a lasting impact on the field of library administration and education.







Latest Publication

The book had informative eighteenth chapters. The outstanding contribution of authors presented an exceptional dimension on pandemic pedagogy in relation to academic library and pandemic pedagogy mainly in higher education.
