UB-Study Circle (27th Session)

The 27th study circle of universal briefing took place on 2nd March. The speaker for the session was Jaya Sharma, Librarian, Government General Degree College Singur, Hooghly, West Bengal & Research Scholar, Department of Library and Information Science, Jadavpur University. The President of the session was Dr. Suparna Naskar, Librarian, Kandi Raj College, Murshidabad. The topic of the study circle was "Open Educational Resources: A Holistic View from Definition to Application".

The speaker provided an overview of Open Educational Resources. She elaborated the concept of open educational resources and its impact on education system. She elaborately described types, attributes, and licensing models of OER. She also illustrated what contents are not OER. She mentioned about initiatives at global and national level. She discussed how to select, evaluate, adapt and use OER. Additionally, she provided guidelines on how librarians can play a significant role in wider use of OER. In a nutshell, through her detailed but compact presentation, the speaker touched upon every aspect of OER.

Retrospective Highlights



Detailed Report:

A Two-Day International Seminar on "Intellectual Property Rights and the Conundrum of Information Managers Towards Creating an Open Society" was organised by Universal Briefing, Kolkata along with Central Library, Derozio Memorial College, Kolkata, and Open Access Bangladesh on 17-18th February 2024 at TEQIP Building Auditorium, Jadavpur University, Kolkata. Our seminar's theme highlighted the crucial task of balancing innovation and ensuring fair access to knowledge with wisdom and foresight. Over those two days, the event delved into thought-provoking discussions from experts in the field, and new and innovative ways to address the conflict between IPR and the creation of an open society were explored.

Dr. Ranjan Samanta, General Secretary, Universal Briefing and Librarian, Naba Ballygunge Mahavidyalaya, Kolkata, in his welcome speech, briefly discussed the objectives, activities, and journey of Universal Briefing towards creating a knowledge society. Prof. B. V. Sharma, Director-General, Raja Rammohun Roy Library Foundation, Ministry of Culture, Government of India inaugurated the seminar, and shared his experiences of visits to different libraries across India and emphasized the role of library and information science professionals and researchers in nation-building through qualitative research. Prof. Prabhakar Rath, Former Vice-Chancellor, Mizoram University, Professor, Department of Library and Information Science, Mizoram University, and Chief Guest of the seminar, efficiently described the three facets - IPR, Information Managers, and Open Society - associated with the seminar topic. Prof. Rath also shared his views about the conflict between IPR and Open Data and how libraries can provide Open Access data without compromising IPR.

Prof. Udayan Bhattacharya, Director of the seminar, shared his experience about how Universal Briefing is helping students and scholars to flourish their intellectual thoughts. Prof. Bhattacharya also shared the relevance of the seminar topic in the present era. Dr. Saikat Mondal, President of the seminar, welcomed all to the seminar and also shared his thoughts about why IPR is needed to protect the creator's right.

Prof. R.K. Bhatt, Professor, Department of Library and Information Science, University of Delhi, the keynote speaker of the seminar, shared his intellectual thoughts about how Ranganathan gives importance to local libraries.

Prof. Bhatt also suggested concrete policies and actions that should be framed for libraries to properly maintain the documents created during Azadi ki Amrit Mahotsav. Prof. Bhat also emphasized marketing library resources to maximize resource utilization and proposed that every research scholar should have knowledge about academic integrity and professional ethics.

Dr. Shalini Lihitkar, Prof, Dept. of Library and Information Science, Shivaji University, was invited to speak in the first session, and the topic of the session was "Creative Commons and Open Licensing". Prof. Arun Kumar Chakraborty, Former- DG, RRRLF & National Library, Kolkata, Professor & Head, Dept. of Library and Information Science, Netaji Subhas Open University, Kolkata acted as the chairperson and Dr. Ziaur Rahaman, Associate Professor & Head, Dept. of Library and Information Science, Rabindra Bharati University, Kolkata acted as co-chairperson of the first technical session. Dr. Lihitkar shared her experience about copyright, creative commons, open licensing, different types of licensing, and engagement, etc.

Prof. Subhrojyoti Bhowmick, Clinical Director - Academics, Quality & Research Department, Peerless Hospital, Kolkata, acted as the chairperson and Dr. Pubalika Bhattacharya Maitra, Assistant Professor, Dept. of Library and Information Science, University of Calcutta, Kolkata acted as co-chairperson of technical session 2, and the topic of the session was "IPR and Health industry" Dr. Bhowmick shared valuable thoughts about the importance of IPR and why patents are needed. He also narrated how much money is involved in R & D and clinical trials in the drug industry and it is because of patents, that companies or organizations engage in the research.

Prof. R. K. Mahapatra, Professor & Head, Department of Library and Information Science, Tripura University, was invited to speak in the 3rd session, and the topic of the session was "Government initiatives towards IPR in India and abroad". Session chairperson was Prof. Pravakar Rath, Professor & Head, Department of Library and Information Science, Mizoram University, Mizoram where Co-Chairperson was Dr. Mahuya Bhoumik, Associate Professor & Head, Department of English, Derozio Memorial College, Kolkata. Prof. Mahapatra covered IPR-related Government initiatives in India and abroad.

Prof. Durga Shankar Rath, Professor, Dept. of Library and Information Science, Vidyasagar University, was invited to talk in session 4, and the topic of this session was "IPR, sustainability issues and Green revolution". Dr. Nimai Chand Saha, Librarian and University Librarian (Acting), Visva-Bharati, West Bengal acted as chairperson and Dr. Tapan Barui, Assistant Professor, University of North Bengal, Darjeeling acted as co-chairperson. Prof. Rath shared his views about IPR and Traditional Knowledge, the importance of IPR, TKDL, Bio-Piracy, and misuse of traditional knowledge, etc.

Dr. Ch. Ibohal Singh, Professor, Department of Library and Information Science, Manipur University, was invited to talk in session 5, and the topic of this session was "IPR and social media". Chairperson and co-chairperson were Prof. Subarna Kumar Das, Professor, Department of Library and Information Science, Jadavpur University, Kolkata and Dr. Sibshankar Jana, Associate Professor, Dept. of Library and Information Science, Kalyani University, Nadia. Prof. Singh discussed Intellectual Property, social media, its challenges, strategies for protection, important areas of research, licensing of social media content, etc.

Dr. S. Dhanavandan, Deputy Librarian, Central University of Tamil Nadu, was invited to talk in session 6, and the topic of discussion of this session was "Practical aspects of IPR including case studies, legal proceedings etc".





Dr. Moses Mark Naga, Professor & Head, Department of Library and Information Science, North-Eastern Hill University, Shillong jointly chaired the session with Dr. Ch. Ibohal Singh, Professor, Department of Library and Information Science, Manipur University. Dr. Dhanavandan discussed practical aspects of IPR, the process to get a patent, trademark, copyright infringement, violation of law, etc.

Dr. Amit Kumar, Associate Professor & Head, School of Library and Information Science, Central University of Gujarat, was invited to talk to session 7, and the topic of this session was "IPR and social media contexts". Prof. R. K. Mahapatra, Professor & Head, Department of Library and Information Science, Tripura University acted as chairperson and Dr. Prabin Karkee, Assistant Professor, Department of Library and Information Science, University of Gour Banga, Malda acted as co-chairperson in that session. Dr. Kumar discussed privacy concerns of social media, authenticity, cyber-attacks, IP on social media, etc.

Dr. Moses Mark Naga, Professor & Head, Department of Library and Information Science, North-Eastern Hill University, Shillong, was invited to talk to session 8. The topic of this session was "IPR and traditional knowledge". Dr. Parikshit Mondal, Associate Professor, Department of Library and Information Science, University of Calcutta, Kolkata acted as chairperson of that session. Dr. Naga discussed safeguarding traditional knowledge related to herbal medicinal plants through proper documentation and IPR like copyright.

Dr. Manirul Islam of Open Access Bangladesh, Librarian, Prime Minister's Office, Dhaka, Bangaladesh was invited to talk in parallel session 8. Parallel session was chaired by Dr. Tapan Barui, Assistant Professor, University of North Bengal, Darjeeling. Dr. Islam discussed various aspects of IPR in Bangladesh. Prof. Amitava Datta, Pro-Vice-Chancellor of Jadavpur University, delivered the valedictory address.

The seminar comprised eight technical sessions with the focus on themes like Creative Commons and Open Licensing, IPR and Health industry, Government initiatives towards IPR in India and abroad; IPR, sustainability issues and green revolution, IPR and the social media, Practical aspects of IPR including case studies, legal proceedings etc., IPR and social media contexts, IPR and the traditional knowledge and one parallel session. Eight speakers, all well-known eminent professionals of the library science field and beyond, delivered invited lectures. A total of 52 papers were presented in the seminar by the participants which mainly consisted of LIS students and library professionals, and the discussions covered a myriad of topics and concepts including transformative impact of open licensing, the interdisciplinary landscape of open data the implications of IPR in the context of pharmaceuticals and public health in developing countries like India, the rights of differently abled individuals under Indian Copyright Law, the sociological theories and philosophical doctrines to understand the concept of society through individual perspectives, Classification of Interdisciplinary nature of Open Data Literature from a Machine Learning approach, the Traditional Knowledge Digital Library's (TKDL) role in safeguarding India's traditional knowledge within Intellectual Property Rights (IPRs), Pharmaceutical Patent in India, Fake News, Social Media Algorithms, and Intellectual Property Laws in the modern era, Geographical Indications In India, open science and IPR, Radical humanism and open society, Global Framework for IPR, the challenges of cyber-squatting in the digital era, Sustainable Utilization of Resources for an Open Society and many more.

Dr. Soumen Mondal, Librarian, Prasanta Chandra Mahalanobis Mahavidyalaya, Kolkata acted as the Rapporteur General of the seminar. The formal vote of thanks was delivered by Dr. Swapan Khan, General Secretary, Universal Briefing, Kolkata and Librarian, Narasinha Dutt College, Howrah. 4-YEAR BACHELOR (HONOURS WITH RESEARCH) // IN UBRARY AND INFORMATION SCIENCE अमृत महोत्सव

Introduction

Introduced by Department of Library & Information Science, Mahatma Gandhi Central University in 2024, the 4-Year Bachelor (Honours with Research) programme in Library & Information Science is the first of its kind in India under NEP-2020. The programme has been accredited by the University Grants Commission (UGC). This innovative and distinctive curriculum is designed for young students who want to become information professionals or leaders in the field of library & information science. Through this programme, the department hopes to draw in young students and shape them into exceptional leaders.

Scope:

This full-time course is divided into eight semesters leading to the degree of 4-Year Bachelor (Honours with Research) Programme in Library and Information Science. The programme focuses on students who have passed out of class XII/Higher Secondary or equivalent from schools across India. The students will also be able to pursue higher studies in library and information science.

Eligibility:

To be eligible for admission, a student should have successfully completed 10 + 2 (Higher Secondary Education) in any discipline from Central/State Government recognized Board having minimum 50% marks or equivalent grade (5% marks relaxation for SC/ST/OBC (Non-creamy layer)/PwD Candidates).

Mode of Selection:

Each candidate applying for admission to this programme must take a CUET (UG) - 2024 selection test conducted by NTA. Multiple Entry & Exit Options:

The course curriculum is based on the New Education Policy (NEP) -2020 with multiple entry and exit. There is an exit option after each year of the programme as follows:-

- Lexit after First Year with a Certificate in Library & Information Science (C.Lib.L.Sc.) degree.
- Exit after Second Year with a Diploma in Library & Information Science (D.Lib.I.Sc.) degree.
 Exit after Third Year with a Bachelor in Library & Information Science (B.Lib.I.Sc.) degree.
- After the Fourth Year a student can receive a 4-Year Bachelor in Library & Information Science-
- B.Lib.L.Sc. (Honours) degree, below 75% marks.
 Above 75% marks in the Fourth Year a student can receive B.Lib.L.Sc. (Honours with Research) degree. This degree may be regarded for the purpose of entry to Ph.D. programmes.
- However, there is an option to do one-year Masters in Library and Information Science if the student scores below 75% marks in 4-Year B.Lib.I.Sc. (Honours) degree.

MS COPILOT

Copilot is an artificial intelligence (AI) tool that combines natural language with linguistic models, data, and Microsoft Graph to improve employee productivity using everyday applications such as Word, Excel, Outlook, Teams, or PowerPoint. It also works with the Bing search engine and Windows operating system (OS).

<u>Versions:</u> Initially, Copilot was only available on Windows 11. It has since been made available on the latest version of Windows 10. In late 2024, Microsoft is expected to issue a significant update to Windows. There is some dispute as to whether it will be called Windows 12 or remain Windows 11. In either event, Copilot for this new release will be more fully integrated and have additional features, such as self-customization, automatic repair and enhanced security features that eclipse earlier versions of Windows. Besides Bing and Edge, Copilot is only available for the Microsoft 365 suite. It does not support the locally installed version of the productivity software -- Office 2021/2019/2016 and earlier.

<u>Use:</u> Users ask Copilot questions in a conversational, natural language style as they would with ChatGPT. As with any internet search, context is vital. Users should provide their question with as many keywords as possible. Copilot is not autopilot. It is an assistant that requires human intervention and effort. In Word, Excel, PowerPoint and Outlook, users can generate text and then have Copilot complete or rewrite it. Copilot can summarize a document and provide a concise overview of the contents. It can also turn text into data tables. In Microsoft Teams, Copilot can provide summaries and recaps of meetings, going over key points and action items. During the meeting, it can provide response suggestions and other talking points, as well as translations from foreign languages. For more information Click HERE.

"Preserving the Past: The Legacy of Sundarban Hazi Desarat College's Sundarbans Museum"



Sundarban Hazi Desarat College, located on Pathankhali island in the Sundarbans near Gosaba, has inaugurated a comprehensive museum housing a diverse range of artifacts and materials associated with the Sundarbans. The museum's primary objective is to enrich students' understanding of the region's history, heritage, art, and culture. Situated approximately 100 kilometers south of Kolkata, this 63-year-old

institution stands as the sole college within the Sundarbans Gosaba block stands as a

beacon of hope for local residents aspiring for higher education. This college has amassed a wealth of information pertaining to the Sundarbans, with researchers extensively utilizing the array of Sundarbans-related books housed in its library. Recognizing the significance of preserving this wealth of knowledge, the college authorities felt to establish a museum on campus. Its inception traces back to 1961, initiated by freedom fighters from Midnapore who established the college on the island.

The Sundarban Hazi Desarat College owes its remarkable museum to the visionary efforts of Sukumar Mondal, a diligent 39-year-old librarian. Dubbed the 'Sunderban Museum,' this ambitious project was officially unveiled on March 5th, 2024, under the auspices of Professor Udayan Bhattacharya of Department of Library and Information Science, Jadavpur University. The inauguration ceremony, attended by students, researchers, and local islanders, saw the esteemed presence of Sukumar Poira, a former Sundarbans teacher, researcher and collector Ujjwal Sardar, alongside college principal Tarun Mandal. Librarian reflected on the arduous journey of gathering Sundarbans-related artifacts and verified data for the museum's archives, emphasizing the significant challenges encountered along the way. He highlighted the persistent interest from researchers visiting the college seeking knowledge on the Sundarbans and diverse literary resources. Motivated by this demand, Sukumar embarked on the museum project in 2020, navigating various obstacles and rallying support from collectors for voluntary contributions.

As per college insiders, the establishment of the library owes much to the tireless dedication of librarian Sukumar Mandal. Moreover, the museum owes its existence to the invaluable contributions of Ujjwal Sardar, a distinguished collector and researcher of the Sundarbans, attached to Rajshahi University, Bangladesh. He expressed the intention behind portraying these artifacts through miniature idols, aiming to acquaint visitors with local rituals and cultures.



Sardar generously donated a significant portion of his personal Sundarbans-related collection to the museum, hoping for its continued prosperity who provided various materials from his collection. The museum boasts a collection of 89 titles related to the Sundarbans, featuring notable artifacts such as a 1st-century AD clay pottery unearthed from Tilpi village near the Piyali riverbank, an ancient idol of a mother goddess dating back to the early Gupta period discovered in Gobardhanpur at G-plot in Pathar Pratima block, and an exceedingly rare Re 1 banknote introduced by Daniel Mackinnon Hamilton in Gosaba in 1934. The museum showcases 27 varieties of miniature clay idols depicting Hindu deities, as well as 'pirs' (Muslim warrior saints), which continue to be revered by the islanders. Additionally, numerous myths are intertwined with the island's culture, including tales of Banabibi, Dakshinaraya, Ateshwar, Kaluraya, Manikapir, Satabibi, Makalthakur, Narayani, Shitala, Manasa, and others. Furthermore, a collection of postage stamps related to the Sundarbans is on display, alongside advertising posters and booklets from the iconic film 'Amanush,' directed by Shakti Samant and based on the story penned by Shaktipad Rajguru, capturing the essence of the Sundarbans. In addition, the museum features artifacts sourced from various archaeological sites across the Sundarbans. Particularly noteworthy are items such as Kushan period pottery, ancient terracotta Matrika idols, basket prints, and ancient Kardis. The collection also includes toys and multiple maps detailing the Sundarbans region.
