### 37th Study Circle

The 37th study circle of universal briefing took place on 4th January at 7.30 pm. The speaker for the session was Dr. Avik Roy, Librarian, Derozio Memorial College, Rajarhat, North 24 Parganas, West Bengal and the President of the session was Dr. Swapan Khan, Librarian, Narasinha Dutt College, Howrah, West Bengal. The topic of the study circle was "Al Tools for Research: a voyage or an excursion".

The speaker delivered an insightful speech on the topic mentioned above. He began by defining research, highlighting the essential roles of analysis, organization, synthesis, and report writing as key components of the research process. He also explained how these steps are foundational to any study, and then proceeded with a hands-on demonstration of various Al tools that aid each phase. For analysis, he showcased Dimensions.ai, a comprehensive database linking grants, publications, patents, and more; Inciteful, which helps users explore topics and uncover connections; and Elicit, an Al tool that streamlines the gathering and synthesis of information using NLP and LLM. Moving to the organization and synthesis phases, he demonstrated ResearchRabbit, which creates personalized literature discovery networks and tracks related works. For report drafting, he introduced Trinka, an Al writing assistant for academic content, offering grammar, clarity, citation checking, and journal recommendations, and Voyant, a powerful tool for text analysis and visualizing large datasets. Overall, it was a very informative and enriching session, providing valuable insights into how Al tools can enhance every step of the research process.



### **Obituary**

### Dr. P. S. G. Kumar: A Tribute to a Luminary in Library and Information Science



It is with profound sorrow that we announce the passing of Dr. P. S. G. Kumar, a stalwart in the field of Library and Information Science, on January 3, 2025. Dr. Kumar, the former Librarian of Rashtrasant Tukadoji Maharaj Nagpur University and Head of its Department of Library and Information Science, leaves behind an indelible legacy. His demise marks an irreplaceable loss to the profession and to countless students, colleagues, and admirers who were inspired by his unparalleled contributions. Dr. Kumar was a prolific writer and academician whose scholarly output is both remarkable and enduring. Over his illustrious career, he authored an impressive 70 books and 142 research papers. His works include monumental contributions such as Indian Library Chronology (two editions), Indian Encyclopedia of Library and Information Science (23

volumes), Kumar's Curriculum Series (16 volumes), and Library in India Series (10 volumes), among others. These publications have served as foundational texts for students and professionals in the field, elevating the standards of library science education and research in India.

An exemplary academic, Dr. Kumar's first-class career spanned from a B.Sc. in Agriculture to an M.Lib.Sc., culminating in a Ph.D. from Gulbarga University. His academic brilliance was matched by his leadership in professional organizations. He held pivotal roles in numerous national and international bodies, including the Indian Library Association (ILA), the Indian Association of Teachers of Library and Information Science (IATLIS) for 12 years, the Joint Council of Library Associations in India (JOCLAI), the Library Association of SAARC Countries (LASAARC) for one term, the Good Offices Committee (GOC), and the Vidarbha Academic Library Association (VALA) for four years. Additionally, he served as a Council Member of IASLIC for two terms. Dr. Kumar's legacy extends beyond his scholarly works and leadership roles. Friends, colleagues, and students have established enduring initiatives in his honor, such as the Dr. P. S. G. Kumar Oration on Library and Information Science (with RTM Nagpur University), the Dr. P. S. G. Kumar Lifetime Achievement Award (with ILA), and the Dr. P. S. G. Kumar Library Foundation at Nagpur. This foundation sponsors two esteemed journals: Mahiti Yug (Information Age) in Marathi and Information Age in English, ensuring his contributions continue to inspire future generations.

As we bid farewell to this towering figure, we celebrate his extraordinary life and achievements. On behalf of Universal Briefing, we extend our deepest condolences to his family, friends, and the entire library science community. May the Almighty grant his soul eternal peace and his legacy everlasting life in the annals of our profession.












### **UB-Self Publication**


