very informative and insightful for learners, teachers, administrators, policy makers and government.










Commercial Use of AI for book translation:

Taylor & Francis to make more translated books available more quickly using advanced AI. Until now, the time and resources required to translate books has meant that the majority remained accessible only to those who could read them in the original language. Books that were translated often only became available after a significant delay. With the development of sophisticated AI translation tools, it has become possible to make these important texts available to a broad readership at speed, without compromising on accuracy. To ensure the quality of these translations, the team at Taylor & Francis has spent a year testing different AI tools, a process which included assessment of AI outputs by expert translators and detailed comparisons of AI versions with those produced by human translators. The festival's main goal is to reintroduce reading habits among individuals, particularly the younger generation, in an era where digital content prevails. The festival has already garnered a massive reaction, with book fans coming to the venue on the opening day. Organizers were pleasantly surprised by the volume of books sold, reaffirming their opinion that there is still a strong need for physical books.
